1. PURPOSE

To provide for appropriate and lawful use of Foundation resources.

2. APPLICABILITY

All members of Advancement staff.

3. POLICY

The Foundation has received a determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service that it is a tax-exempt organization as described in Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). The Foundation will not, and no person acting directly or indirectly on behalf of the Foundation will, participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distributing of statements or the use of Foundation resources, including mailing lists, for any such publication or distribution.

No substantial part of the Foundation's activities will consist of lobbying or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except to the extent permitted by applicable law and regulations for not-for-profit, tax-exempt organizations. The University President or his or her designees shall direct all activities which may be deemed to fall within this policy.
